Clubs (breakfast & after-school)

Our breakfast club operates from 8.00am every day. Each session will cost £3.00 per child and £2.00 each for any other children in the same household, unless pupil premium, which remains free. All places will need to be booked in advance and you can book as many sessions as you wish over a week. If you would like to book a place for your child, please log on to School money our online cashless system.

Our after school club will operate from the end of the school day until either 4pm (short session) or 5.30pm (long session), Mondays to Fridays. At the after school club, the children are provided with a drink, a piece of toast and a piece of fruit. There will be a mixture of opportunities for play and learning, including support with homework as well as outdoor physical activities. We require places to be booked at least 24 hours in advance. You can cancel sessions without charge up to 24 hours in advance. Sessions cancelled less than 24 hours in advance will still be charged
