SchoolMoney

We are delighted to info we have recently signed up to the online payment system SchoolMoney. This means that you will now have the facility to make payments or school expenses. You will not need to sign up to this system as this has been done automatically through the school and as long as you have provided us with up to date contact details we will have sent you a password. This password will give you access to your SchoolMoney account where you can pay for any items we have requested from you.

To log into SchoolMoney, visit the website www.eduspot.co.uk and click on the sign in button in the top right hand corner. In the drop down, select the SchoolMoney Parent Login option and this will send you through to a page where you need to enter your mobile number, email address, the password we have sent to you, and your child's first name. If for any reason you are struggling to log in, it may be because you have not provided us with the correct contact details. Please let us know immediately if either your mobile number or email address changes.

Clubs (breakfast & after-school)

Our breakfast club operates from 8.00am every day. Each session will cost £3.00 per child and £2.00 each for any other children in the same household, unless pupil premium, which remains free. All places will need to be booked in advance and you can book as many sessions as you wish over a week. If you would like to book a place for your child, please log on to School money our online cashless system.

Our after school club will operate from the end of the school day until either 4pm (short session) or 5.30pm (long session), Mondays to Fridays. At the after school club, the children are provided with a drink, a piece of toast and a piece of fruit. There will be a mixture of opportunities for play and learning, including support with homework as well as outdoor physical activities. We require places to be booked at least 24 hours in advance. You can cancel sessions without charge up to 24 hours in advance. Sessions cancelled less than 24 hours in advance will still be charged
